

Houston County Field Class Tractor & Truck Pull

Scheduled for Sunday, August 20, 2017 • 11 a.m. in the Grandstands

General Pulling Rules for all Classes:

- 50 lb. grace on scale
- 2 hooks per hook per tractor per event
- Drawbar no higher than 20"
- No 3rd link to drawbar
- 3" hole on clevis
- Driver must stay in seat while pulling
- Front weights must not exceed 24" from front casting of tractor
- Drawbar hitching hole cannot be closer than 18" from centerline of tire axle
- Weights must be clear of clevis and PTO shaft

Hot Farm Tractors:

- Must have steel flywheel & scatter blanket or 3/8"x4" metal band around bell housing unless tractor runs under 30% over stock RPM
- Cut tires allowed
- Must have kill switch
- Must have tip bars— pads no more than 10" off ground
- 12" high sled bumper
- Exhaust stack must face up
- No curved exhaust stacks
- Must have engine side shields
- Driver must wear helmet
- Tractors with factory blowers on considered non-turbo
- Tractors with added on or belt driven blowers are considered turbo

Rules for Specific Classes:

12500# - 13500# Hot Farm

- Tire size 20.8-38 non cut only
- All safety equipment required

6200# - 6700# Hot Farm

- Same engine of make of tractor
- Only one power added source:
 1. Turbo or blower—Turbo limited to 3" inlet – No slot or slugs in turbo
 2. Injection
 3. Nitrous oxide
- Fire suit and extinguisher for alcohol tractors

Paced Pullers:

No Dyno, Paced Classes

- 3500 lb to 7500 lb classes paced at 4 mph
- 8500 lb to 18000 lb classes paced at 6 mph
